Scheme: Pre-Matric Scholarship

The **Pre-Matric Scholarship** is a financial assistance program aimed at supporting students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds in their pursuit of school education. In India, this scholarship is primarily available for **Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), and Other Backward Classes (OBC)** students, as well as students belonging to **minority communities** such as **Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jains, and Zoroastrians (Parsis)**. The objective of the Pre-Matric Scholarship is to minimize the dropout rate in school education by reducing the financial burden on families.

Key Features of the Pre-Matric Scholarship:

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Educational Level:
 - o The scholarship is available for students studying in Class 1 to Class 10 in government or government-recognized schools.
- 2. Family Income:
 - The annual family income must be below a certain threshold, typically:
 - SC/ST students: The family's income should not exceed ₹2.5 lakh per annum.
 - **OBC students**: The income limit is usually around ₹1.5 lakh per annum.
 - Minority students: The income should not exceed ₹1 lakh per annum.
- 3. Community-Based Eligibility:
 - The scholarship is specifically targeted towards students from **Scheduled Castes**, **Scheduled Tribes**, **Other Backward Classes**, and **minority communities**.
- 4. Attendance:
 - o Students must have a **minimum attendance** of 75% in the previous academic year.
- 5. Other Criteria:
 - o The student must be a **regular**, **full-time** scholar in a recognized school.

Scholarship Benefits:

- 1. **Scholarship Amount**: The amount provided under the Pre-Matric Scholarship varies based on the class level of the student.
 - o For Class 1 to Class 5:
 - **Maintenance Allowance**: Students generally receive a fixed amount as a maintenance allowance to cover daily expenses.
 - o For Class 6 to Class 10:
 - Maintenance Allowance: The amount increases for students in these classes. The funds help cover school-related expenses such as uniforms, books, and stationery.
 - **Tuition Fees**: For students in private schools or schools where tuition is charged, the scholarship may cover tuition fees up to a certain limit.
- 2. Additional Support:
 - **Books, uniforms**, and other **study materials** are often provided under this scholarship, depending on the state or central government guidelines.

Application Process:

1. Online Application:

• The application process is typically conducted online through portals like the **National Scholarship Portal (NSP)** or through the state government's **scholarship portal**.

2. Required Documents:

- o **Aadhaar card** or other identity proof.
- o Caste certificate (if applicable).
- o **Income certificate** issued by a competent authority.
- o Bonafide student certificate or school admission letter.
- o Previous year's mark sheet.
- o **Bank account details** of the student (in some cases, a joint account with a parent/guardian).

3. Verification:

After submission, the application is verified by the school and the **District Welfare Officer (DWO)** or **Block Education Officer (BEO)**.

4. Approval and Disbursement:

o Once approved, the scholarship amount is transferred directly to the student's or guardian's bank account through **Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT)**.

Renewal Process:

- To continue receiving the Pre-Matric Scholarship, students must maintain a satisfactory academic record and attendance.
- Renewal applications must be submitted each year with the previous year's academic performance report and proof of continuing education.

Benefits of the Pre-Matric Scholarship:

1. Reduces Financial Burden:

o The scholarship helps reduce the financial strain on families by covering essential educational expenses, ensuring that students can focus on their studies.

2. Encourages Education Continuation:

By providing financial assistance, the Pre-Matric Scholarship reduces dropout rates, especially among students from marginalized and economically weaker sections of society.

3. **Promotes Equality**:

o The scheme promotes **inclusive education** by giving students from disadvantaged communities access to education and empowering them for future success.

4. Support for Minority Communities:

o Special provisions for students from minority communities help ensure their equitable access to education.

Implementation and Monitoring:

- The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (for SC and OBC students) and the Ministry of Minority Affairs (for minority students) oversee the implementation of the Pre-Matric Scholarship program.
- State governments also play a crucial role in disbursing scholarships and monitoring the academic progress of beneficiaries.
