The **Sudakshya Scheme for Girl Child** is an initiative by the **Government of Odisha** aimed at encouraging more girls to enroll in **government-run Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs)** across the state. This scheme aims to promote skill development and technical education among girls by providing financial incentives and support to increase their participation in vocational and technical training programs.

The scheme aligns with Odisha's broader objectives to empower women and improve the socio-economic status of girls through skill-based education, ultimately improving their employability and career opportunities.

## Key Features of the Sudakshya Scheme for Girl Child:

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### Objective:

- To **increase the enrollment of girl students** in government ITIs in Odisha.
  - To empower girls with technical skills and vocational training for better employment opportunities.
  - To promote **gender equality** in technical education.
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### Eligibility Criteria:

1. **Gender:**
    - The scheme is exclusively for **girl students**.
  2. **Enrollment in ITI:**
    - The girl child must be enrolled in a **government Industrial Training Institute (ITI)** in Odisha.
    - It applies to both new admissions and existing girl students.
  3. **Course:**
    - The student must be pursuing courses in recognized **vocational trades** offered by the ITI, such as **electrical, mechanical, electronics, computer trades**, and other relevant fields.
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### Scholarship/Financial Assistance:

1. **Free Education:**
    - Under the Sudakshya Scheme, **no tuition fees** are charged from girl students who are enrolled in government ITIs. This removes a significant financial barrier to education and encourages more girls to pursue technical education.
  2. **Additional Incentives:**
    - The government also provides financial aid to cover other educational costs, such as **books, uniforms, and study materials**.
  3. **Examination Fees:**
    - Examination fees and other mandatory costs are often waived for girl students under this scheme, further reducing the financial burden on their families.
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### Implementation and Enrollment Growth:

- The **Directorate of Technical Education and Training (DTET), Odisha** oversees the implementation of the Sudakshya Scheme across various government ITIs in the state.

- Since its launch, the scheme has seen **significant growth in the enrollment of girls** in ITIs, reflecting its success in promoting gender inclusion in technical education.
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### Duration of Support:

- The benefits of the Sudakshya Scheme apply throughout the **entire course duration** in the ITI, typically ranging from 1 to 2 years, depending on the specific trade or vocational program the student is pursuing.
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### Career Opportunities:

1. **Skill Development:**
    - By offering free and subsidized education, the scheme encourages girls to acquire technical skills that can lead to better employment opportunities in industries and the service sector.
  2. **Employment Assistance:**
    - After completing their courses, girl students are also provided with **placement support** and guidance for employment in relevant industries.
  3. **Entrepreneurship:**
    - The scheme indirectly fosters **entrepreneurial skills** by helping girls gain technical expertise, which can be used for self-employment or starting their own ventures.
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### How to Apply:

1. **Admission to ITI:**
    - Girl students need to apply for admission to government ITIs through the **Directorate of Technical Education and Training (DTET)** in Odisha.
  2. **Documents Required:**
    - Proof of identity and residence (Aadhaar card, voter ID).
    - Educational qualification certificates (mark sheets from the previous classes).
    - Caste certificate (if applicable).
    - Admission confirmation letter from the ITI.
  3. **Automatic Enrollment:**
    - Once admitted to a government ITI, girls are automatically eligible for the benefits under the Sudakshya Scheme. No separate application is usually required for the financial benefits, as they are provided by the institution itself.
