#### Merit Cum Means Scholarship for Professional and Technical Courses (Minorities)

#### Introduction to the Scholarship

The Merit Cum Means (MCM) Scholarship Scheme is a centrally sponsored initiative under the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India. It is implemented through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) and aims to provide financial assistance to meritorious students belonging to minority communities who are pursuing professional and technical courses at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels.

#### Objective:

- To support economically disadvantaged students from minority communities.
- To encourage meritorious students to pursue higher professional education.

#### **Target Communities:**

- Muslims
- Christians
- Sikhs
- Buddhists
- Jains
- Zoroastrians (Parsis)

#### **Eligibility Criteria**

#### **General Requirements:**

- Student must belong to one of the notified minority communities.
- Must be pursuing a professional or technical course at UG or PG level.
- Must have secured at least 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination.

#### **Income Criteria:**

- Annual family income should not exceed ₹2.5 lakh.
- Income certificate issued by a competent authority is required.

#### **Institution Type:**

Student must be studying in a recognized institution approved by AICTE, UGC, MCI, DCI, or any regulatory body.

**Note:** Only two students from one family can avail this scholarship.

  - Institution Verification Form
  - Bank Passbook (Aadhaar-linked)
- 7. Submit the application and save the confirmation.
- 8. Wait for institute and state level verification.
