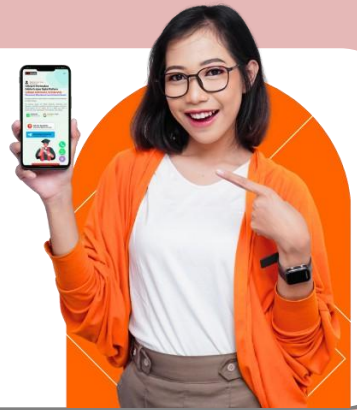

Post-Matric Scholarship for SC/ST/OBC/Minority Students

Introduction to the Scholarship

The Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme is a central sector initiative by the Government of India under the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). It aims to promote higher education by supporting the education of students belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC), and Minority communities after Class 10.

Objective:

- To financially assist students from underprivileged communities for higher studies.
- To improve literacy and learning outcomes among disadvantaged groups.
- To reduce dropout rates after Class 10.

Target Group:

- SC/ST/OBC/Minority** students studying in **Class 11 to post-graduation**, including technical and vocational courses.

Eligibility Criteria

General Requirements:

- Must belong to **SC/ST/OBC or Minority** category.
- Must have passed **Class 10 (Matric)**.
- Must be pursuing **Class 11 to post-graduation** level education in a recognized institution.

Income Criteria:

- SC/ST: Annual family income should not exceed **Rs. 2.5 lakh**.
- OBC: Income should not exceed **Rs. 1 lakh**.
- Minority: Income should not exceed **Rs. 2 lakh** (may vary by scheme).

Other Criteria:

- Must not be receiving any other central government-funded scholarship.
- Regular attendance and satisfactory academic performance required.

Application Process

Step-by-Step Guide:

1. Visit [NSP Portal](#).
2. Complete One Time Registration (OTR) using Aadhaar.
3. Log in with OTR ID and password.
4. Select the appropriate Post-Matric Scholarship based on your category (SC/ST/OBC/Minority).
5. Fill the form carefully.
6. Upload required documents:
7. Submit application and take a printout for records.
8. Application undergoes verification at the institute and state level.





Documents Required

-  Aadhaar Card (Student)
-  Recent Photograph
-  Caste Certificate (issued by competent authority)
-  Income Certificate (current financial year)
-  Academic Mark Sheets
-  Fee Receipt and Admission Proof
-  Bonafide Certificate from Institution
-  Bank Account (Aadhaar-linked)
-  Domicile Certificate (in some cases)






Tentative Dates for 2024–25:

-  Application Start: July 1, 2024
-  Last Date to Apply: December 15, 2024
-  Institute Verification: December 31, 2024
-  State/District Level Verification: January 15, 2025

Do's and Don'ts:

-  Use correct and verified information.
-  Ensure your bank account is Aadhaar-linked.
-  Do not submit duplicate or fake documents.
-  Check NSP portal regularly for updates.
